HOW TO FIND YOUR RING SIZE

We know that ordering rings online can be a little daunting if you don't know your ring size. Whilst we always recommend visiting a local jeweler to have your fingers measured and determine your ring size most accurately, this little guide and template is here to help.

SOME USEFUL TIPS

- Your ring size will vary depending on the time of day. Make sure to measure at the end of the day when fingers are a bit larger than in the morning.
- Temperature affects the size of your fingers. It's best to measure when your fingers are a little warm, as they are smaller when it's cold.
- Slimmer ring designs are a little more forgiving. If in doubt, size up for wider designs.
- Don't forget that your rings must fit over the knuckles too, so it won't help to just measure at the end of the finger where the ring sits.
- The fingers on your dominant hand are wider than on your non-dominant hand. Always think about on which hand you'll want to wear the ring.

MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

If you have an existing ring that fits your preferred finger, you can use our template to determine your size. Just lay your ring over the ring shapes below.

- Print this file in A4 and make sure it is printed to scale (select "actual size").
- Double-check the scale by measuring the bar below. It should be exactly 10cm.
- Place your existing ring over the shapes below until it matches one of the circles.
- If you are between sizes, we recommend sizing up.
